10 years	<b>Adacel-Polio</b>	Tdap-IPV
11-12 years (Girls & boys)	<b>HPV Vaccine</b> <i>Gardasil-9</i> (3 doses)	<b>Human Papilloma virus</b> (Cervical cancer in females, vaginal and vulvar cancers in females, anal cancer in females and males and genital warts in males)
